Accommodations

Participants will stay at Carondelet Center, a retreat and conference facility owned by the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet (www.carondeletcenter.org). All rooms use a shared bath (one for men and one for women). Linens, towels and hair dryers are provided. Breakfast is included with the room fee. All other meals will be in restaurants (chosen by the group) and individuals will pay accordingly.

Registration and Fees

The registration fee of \$15 per person will cover the cost of our meeting room at the retreat center and organizational expenses. Room fees are dependent on whether you choose a private or a shared room. Additional costs will be restaurant meals, your travel expenses, and a small donation for carpool drivers. You are encouraged to find others from your area who will be attending this tour and share rides.

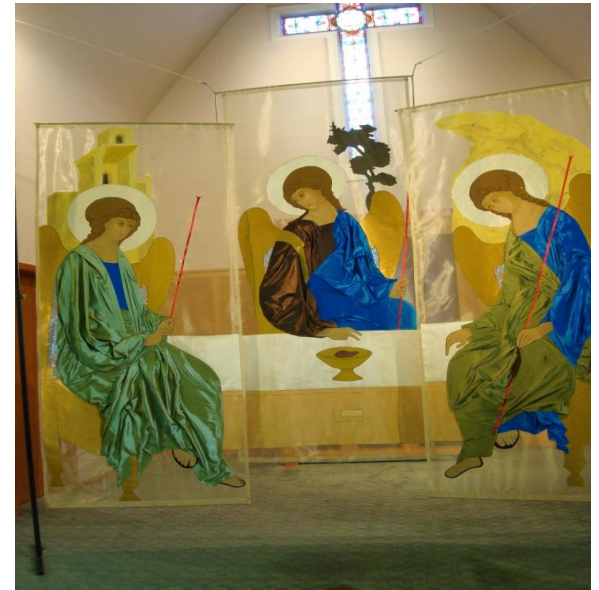
